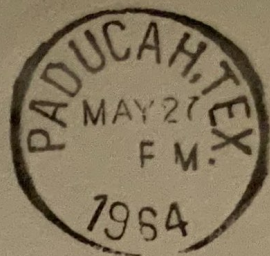
## WHEN YOU THINK YOU CAN
