This has been a wonderful summer! I have seen, heard, and learned so much. My family is wonderful and they have been so good to me.

I hope you have kept up with the news through Mom since I don't have too much time to write. I try to spend as much time with the family as possible.

Mom said in her letter that you will be going to the Valley on Friday to visit and to see Nancy's play. I'm sorry I won't be there to see it.

Each day, here, we have French lessons from about 9-10:30. After that I read from the book (in French) that I am currently trying to read. In the afternoons we go to the lake, visit friends, shop and various other things.

Wednesday we are going to go on a picnic with our bicycles. After tea (5:00) we play games or watch TV till we usually have dinner at 8:30.

My father and the Austrian boy, Jörg are leaving on Saturday. Jörg is going home and Mi Rodallic is going to Germany to study German for 5 months. It is really going to be hard to say goodbye.

The weather here is really varied. Yesterday it rained really hard, and today it is quite warm.

The day this week we might get to visit a castle which is complete with the old furnishings etc.

This life must really agree with me since I've never been so healthy or felt so good. It must be the relaxing atmosphere.

I hope you are feeling well and will take advantage of your vacation to rest.
